Local Issues

Mary Crescent Reserve Playground Upgrade

The long-awaited upgrade of the Mary Crescent Reserve playground is almost here! The new nature-based playground will Include a flying fox, gyro swing, bbqs and a picnic shelter. Works are anticipated to commence onsite at the end of November and are scheduled to be completed by February 2019.

Former Eden Hill Shopping Centre Site

Earlier this year the Town of Bassendean resolved to pursue an Improvement Plan* if inaction on the former Eden Hill Shopping Centre site continued. Following this, the owner has recently provided the Town of Bassendean with a concept plan for the future development of the site.

The concept plan is due to go to the Town of Bassendean Ordinary Council Meeting in November, and if supported, will go out for public comment shortly after.

* An Improvement Plan would involve the Town of Bassendean making a case to the WA Planning Commission that the development of the site is in the community interest. If accepted, this would allow the State Government to seek to acquire and develop the land.

Proposed Walter Road Petrol Station

The Town of Bassendean recently received an application for the development of a petrol station on the corner of Walter Road East and Marion Street Eden Hill.

In its initial assessment of the application, the Town recommended that the application refused. decision be Α application on the was be made by the Metro Central Joint Development Assessment Panel (JDAP) at a meeting held on 31st October. However, at the meeting the JDAP deferred a decision to allow more time to review additional information provided by the applicant. The JDAP meeting at which the application now be will determined is expected to be held in late November.
